- Common Grounds Lee Alexander presented the report. The West side well water is not working. Accurate Drilling Solutions is troubleshooting but there might be challenges with the West side well.
- Welcome Lisa Tackus presented the report. The first rounds have bene completed. There are no new ones this quarter thus far. The request for busines owner's swag to be placed in the welcome packets is posted on the website.
- Social Lee Alexander presented the report. The Spring Event will be held on April 19th which is the Saturday before Easter. Some of the needs are a photographer and bunny. A planning meeting will be held in a few weeks. This is not an association sponsored event but rather a neighborhood event.
- Cameras There is no update.
- Dam Etienne Nortje presented the report. An anonomous donor paid to have brush cleared (~\$2,800) on North side for inspections and also purchased fertlizer and seed "erosion control DOT mix" (~\$3000) for the dam. To realize maximum germination rate, the use of an overseeding machine is required. This is a service provided by existing vendor Turner's Edge. Motion made by Ashley Falvey to approve option 2 on the Turner's Edge Proposal with a maximum expenditure of \$2,000. Motion 2nd by David Parker. Motion passed, unanimous in favor.
